

Using Handouts to Assist Patients

What I need to know about my Primary Care Provider

- A primary care provider is also called a PCP and could be a doctor, nurse practitioner or physician assistant.
- Your PCP is the main provider you see most of the time for care.
- Medical home is another way to talk about a PCP because it is where you go all the time for care.
- Your PCP is listed on the front of your health insurance card. Make sure the PCP listed is who you see regularly for appointments and checkups.
- Go to your PCP for your regular checkups or wellness visits. You can also go to your PCP when you are sick to get medicine. Your PCP can also help monitor ongoing medical conditions.
- There are no limits to how many times you can visit your PCP.

Your Health Care is Changing

STEP 1
Do you have a new Managed Care Organization (MCO) Card? (see sample cards on front)
If YES, go to Step 2
If NO, go to Step 3
Call Member Services to find out your MCO at 1-800-338-8366
Call Member Services to request another card. (Call the number shown on the back of the sample card on front)

STEP 2
Are your regular health care providers in your MCO's network?
If YES, go to Step 3
If NO, don't know - Call the number on the back of the sample card on front
Call Member Services to determine if you want to choose another MCO at 1-800-338-8366

STEP 3
Is the Primary Care Provider (PCP) on the front of your card your regular doctor?
If YES, go to Step 4
If NO, don't know - Call the number on the back of the sample card on front
Call your regular doctor's office to ask the name of your doctor
Call your MCO at the number on the back of your card to switch your PCP to your regular doctor

If you have questions about the services covered through your MCO, call the number on the back of the card.
