

What I need to know about my Primary Care Provider



- A **primary care provider** is also called a **PCP** and could be a doctor, nurse practitioner or physician assistant.



- Your **PCP** is the main provider you see most of the time for care.



- **Medical home** is another way to talk about a **PCP** because it is where you go all the time for care.

- Your **PCP** is listed on the front of your health insurance card. Make sure the **PCP** listed is who you see regularly for appointments and checkups.



- Go to your **PCP** for your regular checkups or wellness visits. You can also go to your **PCP** when you are sick to get medicine. Your **PCP** can also help monitor ongoing medical conditions.
